



METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY

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2009 CASE MANAGEMENT ANALYSIS—THROUGH THIRD QUARTER

Summary of case management statistics in Criminal Court, 2009 compared to 2008, through Q3:

1. There were 5,016 defendants disposed in Criminal Court through Q3 2009. This was an 18% increase over Q3 2008. The average number of days from arrest to disposition declined 6.9% (-19.9 days). During this period, the number of defendants filed in Criminal Court decreased 3%, from 8,328 to 8,074 defendants.
2. The number of defendants disposed by indictment increased 17.8% over the same time period in 2008. Defendants filed in Criminal Court on Presentments/Indictments were down 11% during this same period. The average time from arrest to disposition for indicted defendants dropped 6.2% (-22 days) in 2009Q3 compared to 2008Q3.
3. The number of defendants disposed by Information Agreements increased 34% while the average case age decreased 23% (-19.9 days). Criminal Court defendants filed on Informations increased 16% in 2009Q3, compared to the same period in 2008.
4. There were 18.2% more defendants disposed without a trial in 2009Q3 than in 2008Q3. The case age for non-trial defendants decreased 7.5% (-21.1 days). Defendants disposed by trial increased 7% (from 83 to 89 defendants), while the case age for trial defendants increased 14% (+75.2 days).
5. Jailed defendants disposed in Criminal Court increased 24% through Q3 2009. The defendants took less time to process from arrest to disposition compared to the same period 2008: 10.6 fewer days on average. Disposed defendants on bond increased 13.4% in 2009Q3 over 2008Q3. The average number of days from arrest to disposition for bond defendants decreased by 20.2 days (-5.6%).
6. The total number of defendants issued a capias for FTA in Criminal Court increased 4.6% in 2009Q3 (14 more defendants). The impact of these FTA's on the average case processing time was 4.9 days, which was 1.7 days shorter than the same period in 2008.
7. The number of defendants with disposed probation violations in Criminal Court increased 1.9% (from 2,938 to 2,994) in Q3 2009 compared to Q3 2008. The average number of days from arrest to PV disposition was 29.3 days, which was an increase of 1.8 days (+6.5%) over Q3 2008.

Summary of case management statistics in General Sessions Court, 2009 compared to 2008, through Q3:

1. There were 55,917 defendants disposed in General Sessions Court through Q3 2009. This was a 7.4% increase over Q3 2008. The average case age from arrest to disposition slightly increased 0.6% (+0.4 day). The number of defendants filed in General Sessions Court during this period increased 13.3% over 2008 Q3.
2. The number of defendants boundover decreased 4.4%, and the average case age to disposition decreased 7.9% (-3.2 days).
3. Defendants whose warrants were concluded without a trial increased 8.6% in 2009Q3 compared to the same period last year. The average time from arrest to disposition for this group increased 1.1% (+0.6 day).
4. The total number of jailed defendants increased 3.8%, while the average time to dispose the jailed defendants increased 9% (+0.6 day). Defendants on bond increased 8.6%, while the average case age for this group decreased 1.2% (-0.9 days).
5. The number of defendants issued a capias for FTA increased 4.9% in 2009Q3 (131 more defendants). The impact that the FTA's had on the average case age was 2.7 days, which was 0.1 day less than the same period last year.

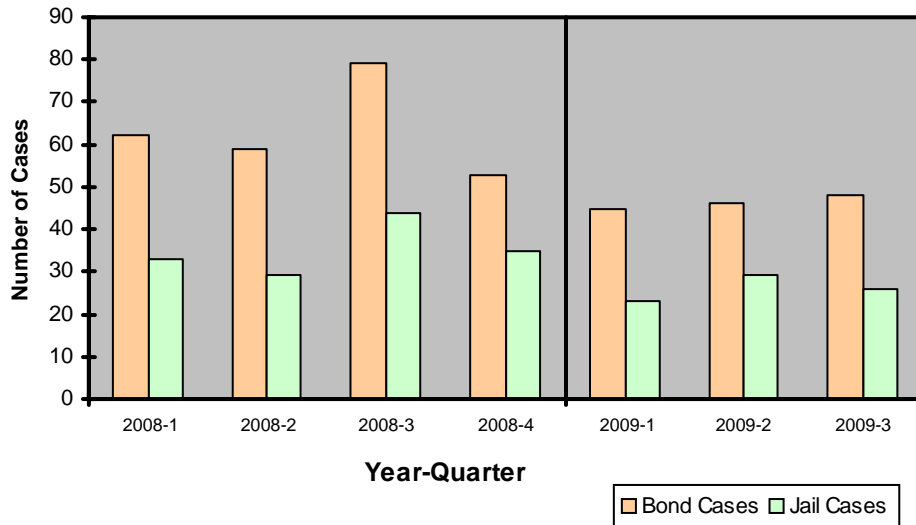

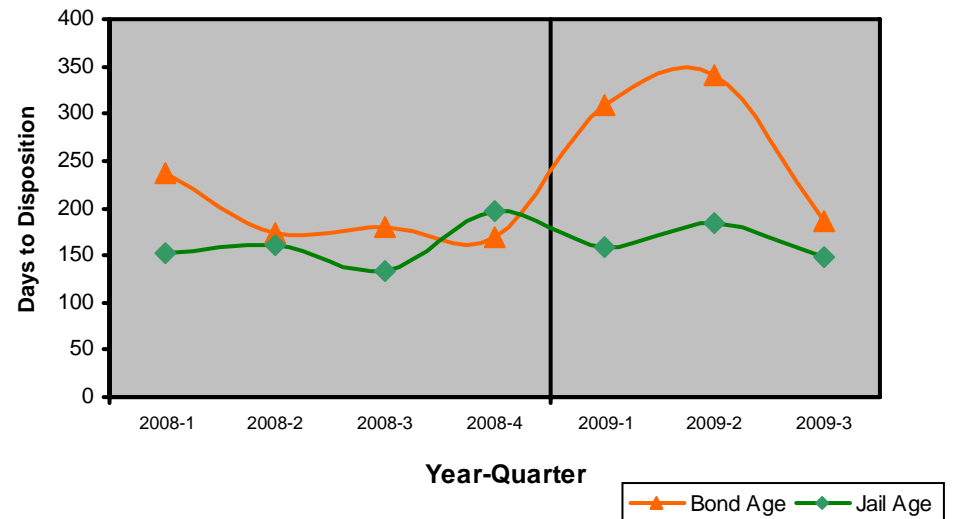

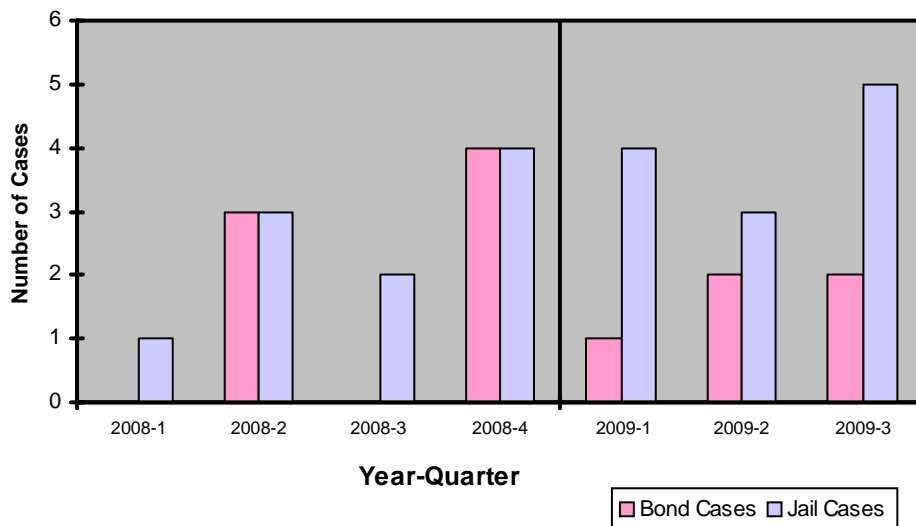
Disposed Without a Trial Number of Cases



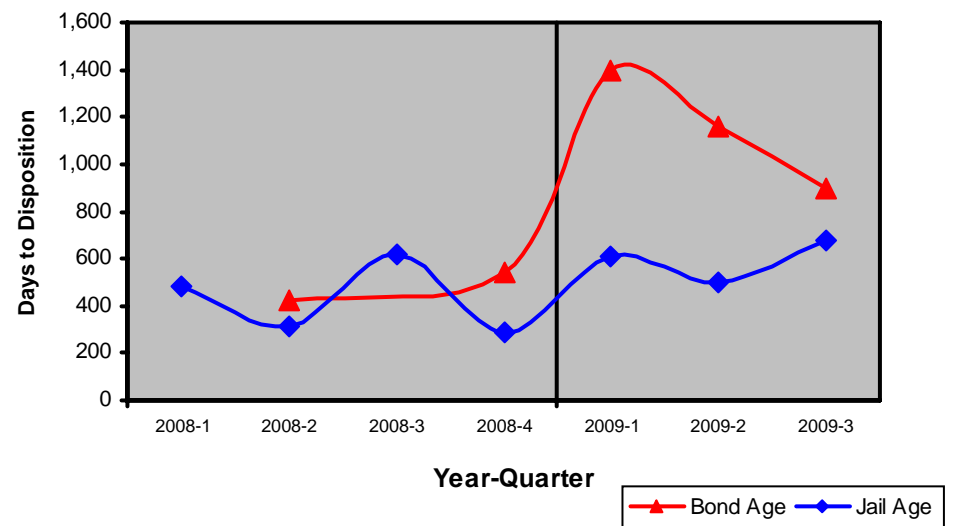
Disposed Without a Trial Average Days to Disposition



Disposed by Trial Number of Cases

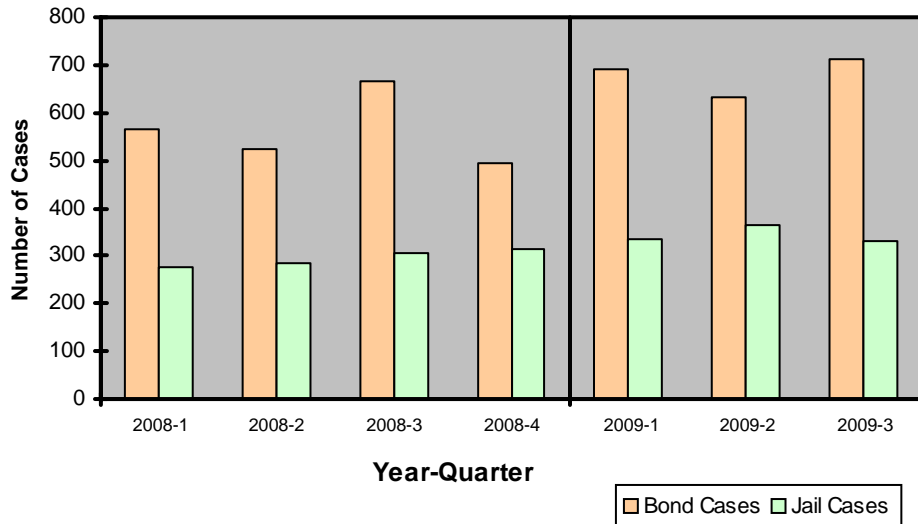


Disposed by Trial Average Days to Disposition

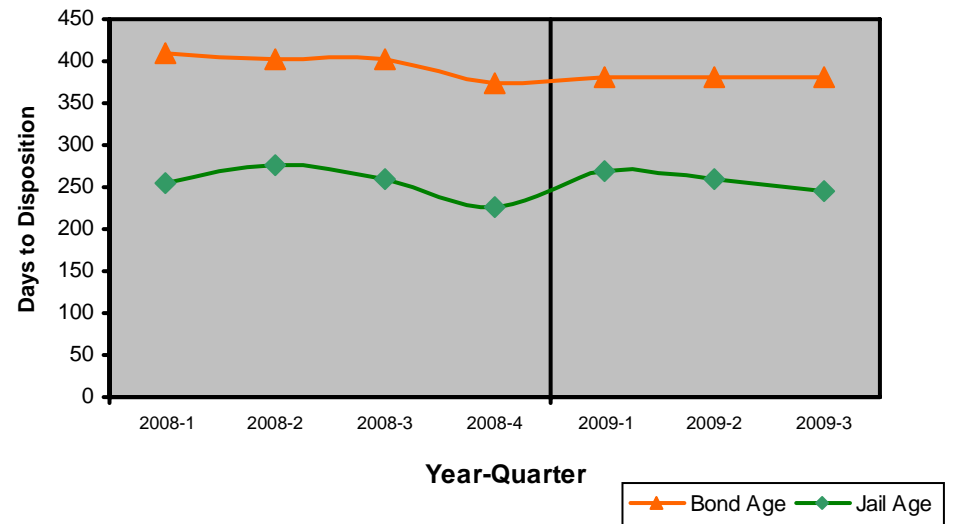

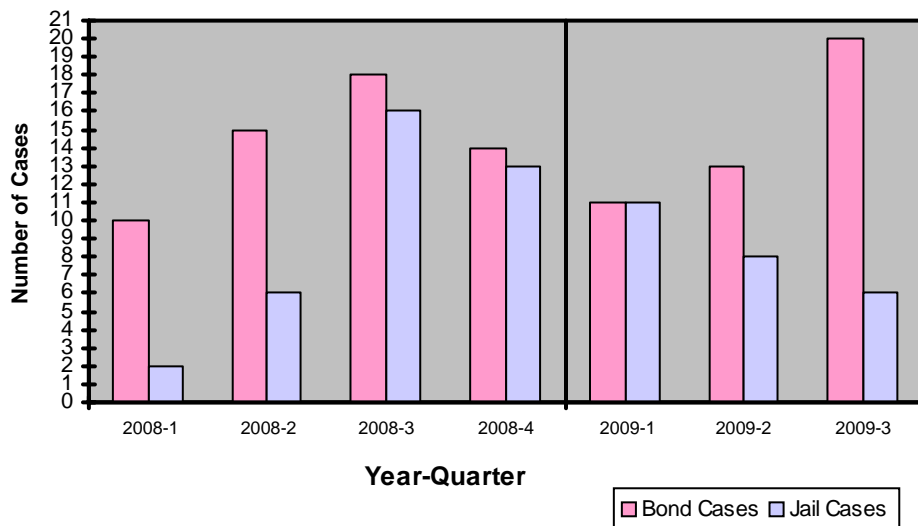
Disposed Without a Trial Number of Cases



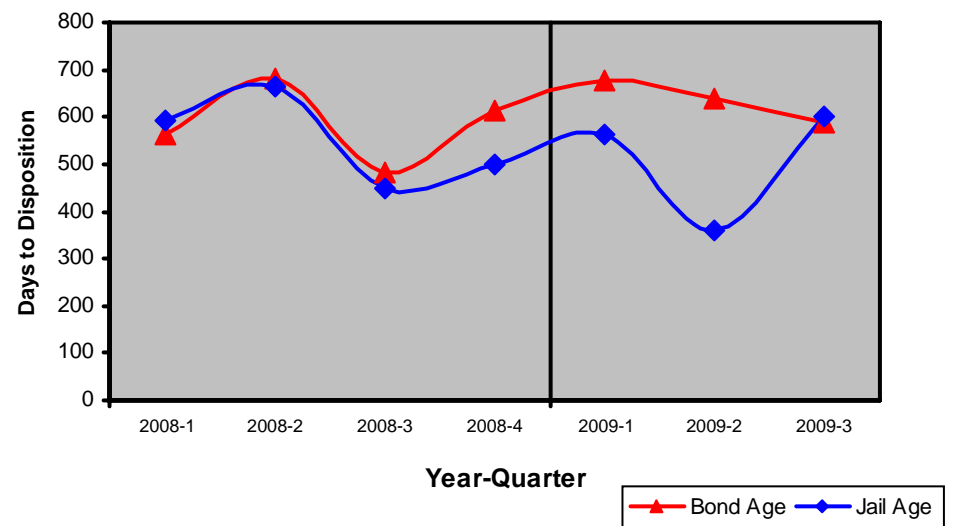
Disposed Without a Trial Average Days to Disposition

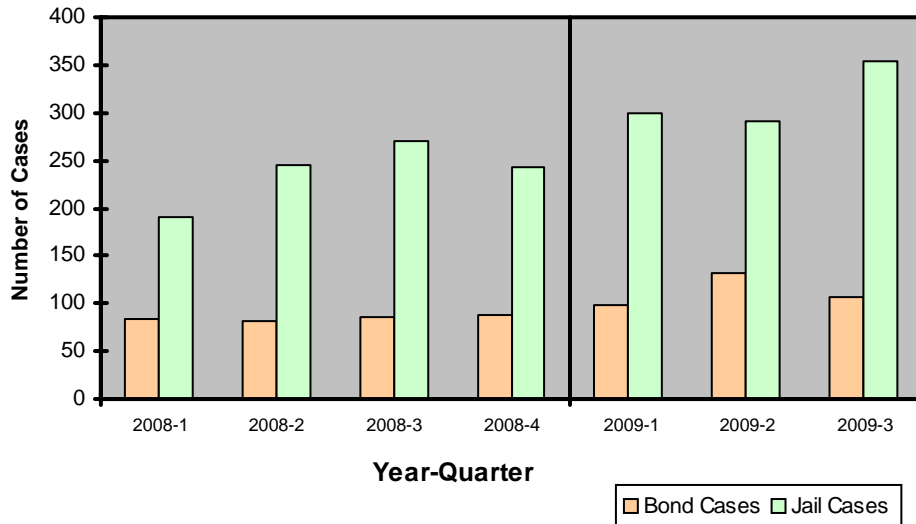

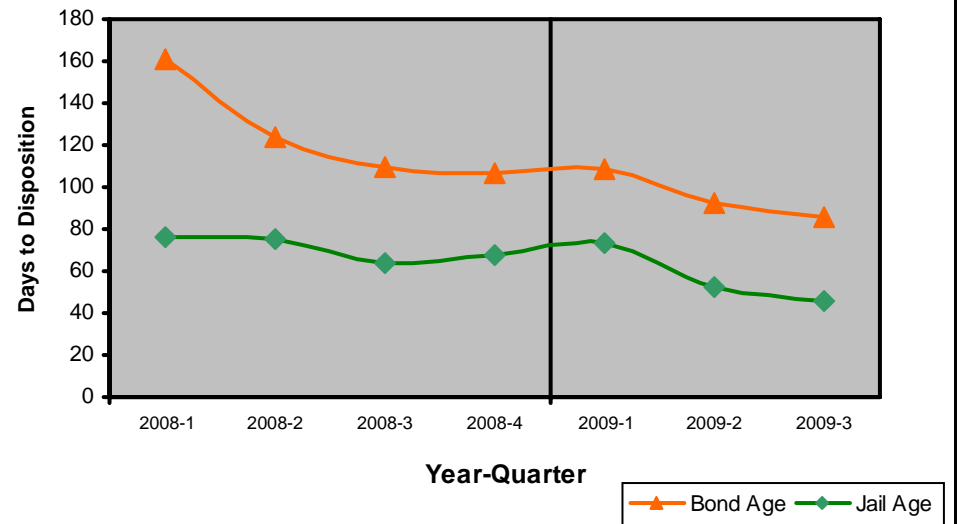

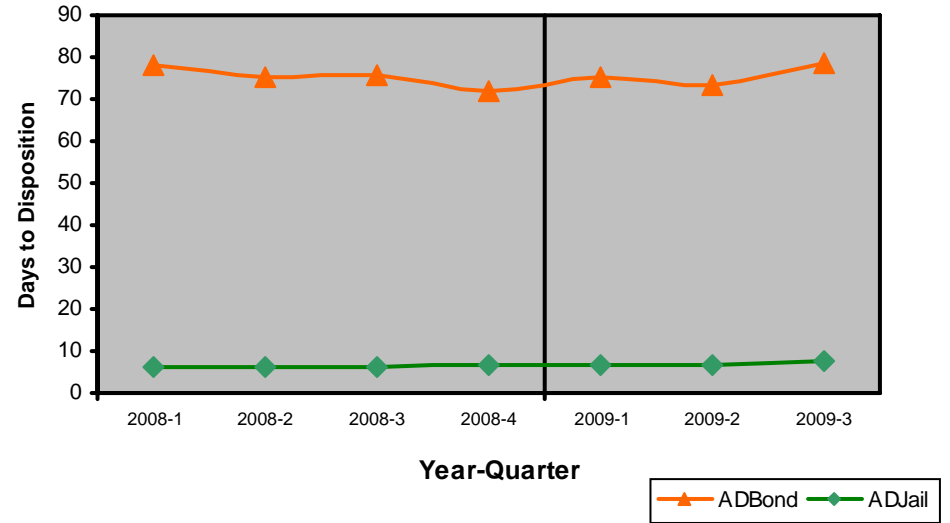

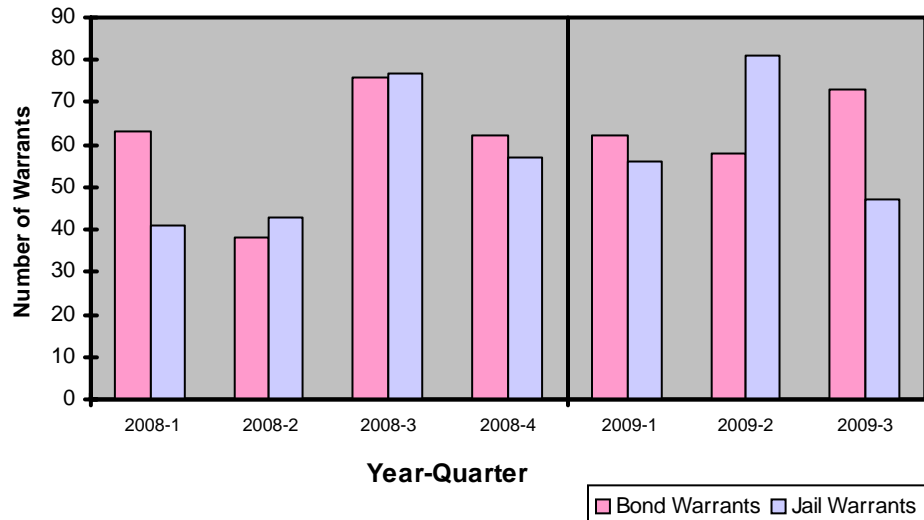
**Boundover/Concluded Without a Trial
Number of Warrants**



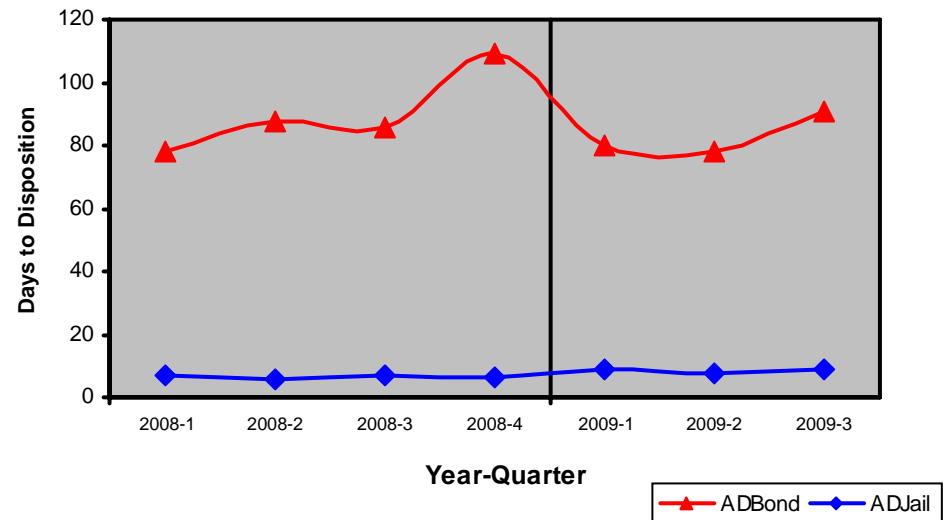
**Boundover/Concluded Without a Trial

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Appendix

Notes:

1. This report is provided on a quarterly basis as a management tool to criminal justice leaders. The purpose of this report is to assist court managers and judges in monitoring the flow of cases through the court system. Successful case flow management can help avoid and reduce unnecessary delay as well as allow more efficient use of time and other resources. This report was developed using guidelines established by the National Center for State Courts. It provides statistics on the average time it takes cases to move from arrest to disposition of the case, for the current year compared to the same time period in the previous year. This analysis is also available by Criminal Court Division.
2. For this report, an outlier test procedure of two standard deviations from the mean is used to determine extreme values which could skew the statistics. Two standard deviations around the mean account for roughly 95 percent of the data population. Values that are determined to be outside two standard deviations are excluded from the statistical calculations. Therefore, the number of cases and defendants reported here is not intended to represent the total number of cases and defendants disposed during the time period.
3. Criminal Court cases are included in this report when all counts for a defendant are disposed. Each defendant is analyzed separately. Therefore, a Criminal Court case can be included in more than one time period if there are multiple defendants with their final count disposed in different quarters.
4. Concerning data on jury trials: This report provides data on the average length of time to dispose a case/defendant therefore it does not include when a jury mistrials and the case remains open. It is also unable to distinguish when a defendant enters a guilty plea after a jury has been impaneled for a trial. At this time the data in CJIS provides no way to accurately identify those cases that started, but did not end, as a jury trial, nor measure the time spent in a trial prior to the guilty plea. Therefore in this report trial cases are defined as cases disposed and recorded in CJIS with disposition by either jury trial or bench trial.

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
