Metro Action Energy Assistance Temporary Satellite Sites to Close Monday

Customers needing help will continue to be assisted at the agency's downtown location

NASHVILLE, Tenn. –Effective Monday (July 20), the Metropolitan Action Commission satellite sites, which served customers needing help with their utility payments, will be closed.

On July 1, in anticipation of increased requests for help during the first few weeks of the new program fiscal year, Metro Action opened two temporary satellite locations in south and east Nashville to ease the numbers of families seeking assistance at the main downtown location.

“Because the numbers of customers we are seeing at the satellite locations have diminished significantly we will close those locations effective Monday,” said Marvin D. Cox, Community Programs Director.

Customers needing help with utility payments as well as other household payments such as rent, mortgage, utility deposits, property taxes and prescriptions will continue to be assisted at the agency's downtown location (1624 5th Avenue North, 37208) Monday through Thursday from 8:00am until 3:00pm.
